Youth Wrestling Season Gets Underway

Five youth wrestlers attended the South Dakota State University Championships in Brookings on Saturday January 7<sup>th</sup>. The tournament included some of the top wrestlers from North Dakota, South Dakota, Iowa, Minnesota, and Nebraska, and Blake Judson (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade division) and Cade Hinkle (3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade division) advanced into the finals at the event. "Both Blake and Cade dominated kids in their first three matches to advanced to the championship matches," said Paul Turman, President for Pierre Youth Wrestling. "They really wrestled well and lost very close matches to come away as runner-ups at the event." The other wrestlers also performed well with a top 4 finish by Jaret Clarke, and a top 8 finish by Gabe Turman and Tyson Johnson.

Eight wrestlers from the program also traveled to Sturgis on the same day to compete with more than 400 wrestlers from South Dakota, Montana, Nebraska, and Wyoming. Representatives from the team came away with three first place finishers in the multi-state tournament including Maguire Raske, Jayden Wiebe, and Jace Bench-Bresher.

"It's always nice to see many of our experienced wrestlers be willing to travel and compete this early in the season," said John Lusk, Vice President for the youth program. "With 150 members in our club we expect many of our new members to begin traveling to tournaments this coming weekend to compete at these closer venues." Local tournaments occurring during January 14<sup>th</sup>-15 weekend include events in Huron and Gettysburg, as well as multiple tournaments in Rapid City and the Black Hills area.
