
Youth Wrestlers Compete Well at Ft. Pierre Invitational

Local wrestlers continued to perform well over the weekend as more than 70 wrestlers from the Pierre Youth wrestling program competed in the Ft. Pierre Invitational on Sunday February 5th. Of the 76 wrestlers that attended the event a total of 36 came away as champions at the tournament.

Practices for the wrestling program began back in early

December and club members use their own discretion in determining the best time to begin competing at tournaments. "The first week of the season we have a number of our more seasoned members travel to compete," said John Lusk, Vice President of the Pierre Youth Wrestling program. "As the season gets underway, we tend to see more and more of our wrestlers attending these tournaments."

Three weeks ago roughly 30 wrestlers competed in tournaments in the Black Hills area, and this number grew to more than 50 two weeks ago at local tournaments in Onida and Highmore. Paul Turman, club president, noted that "Many new members often wait to get adequate practice time in before going out to compete, but once the season draws closer to postseason action we start to see the majority of our members wrestling each weekend."

Tournaments in Faulkton and Lead on Saturday, and Plankinton, on Sunday, attracted wrestlers from the Pierre club as well. Ethan Martinmaas, Aric Williams, Noah Williams, Pryce Dyk, Preston Dyk, Maguire Raske, Jayden Wiebe, and Brady Getz each were champions in Faulkton and brought home the first place team trophy for the event. Gabe Turman, Lincoln Turman, Will Turman and Austin Senger each placed first at the Lead Tournament. While others were competing at the Ft. Pierre tournament on Sunday, Michael Lusk, Blake Judson, and Grant Judson each won championships in Plankinton.
