## Youth Wrestling Continues Into Second Week

Α series of youth wrestling tournaments were held on January 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> with 44 wrestlers from the Pierre Youth Wrestling program participating. Over the course of the two days of of action a total 17 individual champions were crowned along with 12 runner-up finishes.

On Saturday January 12<sup>th</sup> a total of 8 Pierre youth wrestlers competed at the AAU Winter Nationals in Omaha, NE. The tournament

serves as the primary Midwest national tournament for the AAU organization and hosted wrestlers from 14 states. In the Bantam age division, Gabe Turman placed 4<sup>th</sup>, and Jayden Wiebe finished in the top 10 in a larger 32-man bracket. Maguire Raske finished as the runner-up after winning his true-second match at the end of the day in the 10 and under division, and Jack Van Camp finished third having lost a true-second challenge. Will Van Camp went 3-2 at the event but eventually forfeited due to injury finishing in the top 12 of his 64-man division.

Garrett Leesman was the only Pierre wrestler competing in the 12-under division and earned a runner-up finish after a 4-2 loss to the eventual champion from Fort Dodge, IA. Michael Lusk secured a 4<sup>th</sup> place finish after an impressive win in the semifinals in the Schoolboy division, and Will Turman finished in the top 8 in this division losing to opponents from Colorado and Iowa. "While we did well as a club overall at the tournament, we had four kids who lost their opening round match," said Jammie Raske,

advanced group coach for the Pierre Youth Wrestling program. "We need to ready to compete in the opening matches because at tournaments like this, with such large brackets, one really struggles to place when coming through the back-side of the brackets." The next national level competition will be on January 9<sup>th</sup> in Gillette, WY where a larger number of Pierre wrestlers are expected to attend.

In more local action, a total of 26 wrestlers traveled to Gettysburg on Sunday (January 13<sup>th</sup>) to compete in the annual Battler tournament. The tournament is one of a few youth events that allow clubs to compete for team points and the Pierre program came away with the team championship this year. Paul Turman, president of the Pierre Youth Wrestling program, noted that "We always have a good showing at the Gettysburg tournament each year, as we had a number of our new members who used this event as their first time in competition." Of the 26 wrestlers, a total of 12 champions were crowned in the 4-man round-robin format including Tristan

Spencer, Easton Swartz, Spencer Davis, Justyce Murphy, Nicholas Murphy, Aiden Heathcote, Jacoby Taylor, Jacob Mason, Logan Meyer, Matthew Hostler, Shawn Van Liere, and Carson Stoeser. Seven other wrestlers finished at runner-ups (Steven Fullerton, Brady Miller, Jett Zabel, Tyrone Oldenkamp, Zachary Oldenkamp, Spencer Easland, and Tyson Nemec) at the event followed by four third place finishes (Colt Norman, Bryaden Houlette, Mason Dell, and Tristan Nemec), and three fourth place finishes (Spencer Taylor, Ridge Leimbach, and Robert Arnold).

An additional 10 wrestlers competed in tournaments in Huron and Mitchell on Sunday as well with five champions produced at these two events including Gavin Stotts, Hayden Shaffer, Hudson Shaffer, Nathan Williams, and Noah Williams. Runner-ups included Brady Getz, Andrew Snyder, and Kahlor Hindman. Cole Rank finished fourth, and Harlan Stotts placed fifth.

Club members will remain in Pierre this coming weekend to compete at the Pierre Invitational which will be held on Sunday January 20<sup>th</sup> with wrestling beginning at 10:00 a.m. Individual performance for each Pierre youth wrestler includes:
