Local Youth Wrestlers Host Pierre Invitational

Pierre was exposed to a significant amount of wrestling over the weekend, as the Governor wrestling team hosted the VS. East West Dual Tournament, followed by approximately 350 wrestlers competing in the Pierre Youth Wrestling Invitational Sunday on January 20th. Over the weekend, 90 members of the Pierre youth wrestling program competed at the

annual tournament with wrestlers from regional clubs, as well as North Dakota and Nebraska traveling to compete in Pierre.

A total of 21 Pierre wrestlers won individual championships at the tournament across the 52 weight classes and age divisions. The tournament used district style bracketing with designated weight classes with many of the wrestlers competing in 16 man brackets. Champions at the tournament included Alex Odekoven and Carson Stoeser in the 6 & Under division, while Ethan Martinmaas, Matthew Hostler, Jett Zabel, and Gavin Stotts each won in the 7 & 8 year old Gabe Turman, Noah Williams, division. Blake Judson, Hayden Shaffer and Jacob Larson each won their divisions in the 9 & 10 age group, followed by Will Van Camp, Cade Hinkle, and Maguire Raske in the 11 The largest number of & 12 division. champions came from the 13 &14 year old Schoolboy division with wins by Lincoln Turman, Will Turman, Michael Lusk, DJ Highbear, Garrett Leesman, Zane Zilverberg, Gage Gehring, and Easton Swartz.

Jammie Raske, advanced division coach for the Pierre program, noted "When we use the district style bracketing it attracts a lot of top talent from around the state which gives our kids exposure to wrestling in bigger tournaments. It also puts a lot of Pierre kids up against each other and in many of the brackets we had runner-up performances where two kids from our own club had to wrestle in the finals." The program also produced 15 runner-up finishes (Jacob Mason, Keith Gorham, Andrew Snyder, Tristan Spencer, Trey Lewis, Jayden Wiebe, Tyson Johnson, Matthew King, Jace Bench Bresher, Spencer Davis, Harlan Stotts, Justyce Murphy, Logan Meyer, Zachary Rounds, Caden Buchholz and Matthew Rounds), as well as 12 wrestlers winning the consolation championship (Jacoby Taylor, Cayden Morris, Spencer Easland, Elijah Boutchee, Jayce Anderson, Rylan Shrake, Colt Norman, Tyson Nemec, Nate Williams, Steven Fullerton, Brady Getz, Preston Dyk, and Pryce Dyk).

Action continues this weekend as youth wrestlers will have an opportunity to compete in Onida on Friday January 25th, or Highmore on January 27th. A number of
