
Governor Youth Wrestling Advances 62 to State

At total of 88 wrestlers from the Governor Youth Wrestling program competed in the Region 2 Youth Wrestling Tournament held in Mobridge on Saturday March 15th. Wrestlers from around the area competed in the event, which coincided with competition at four other region tournaments held throughout the state. The top three wrestlers from each age division and weight class advance to the State Tournament held in Rapid City in two weeks.

This year, the Pierre program advanced 62 wrestlers to the state tournament. This number is only two short of the record 63 wrestlers that advanced from this same event last year. This included 26 region champions, 20 second place finishers, and 15 third/fourth place finishers. Trevor Wiebe, president of the youth program, noted that "Last year was a banner year for our program, and getting close to that mark again for a second straight year is very rewarding. Just three years ago when we hit broke the 50 mark it was believe that advancing more than that would be difficult to accomplish." The next highest total by a competing youth program around the state was Watertown with 39 state qualifiers.

Other runner-up finishes included Daniel Mason, Xoe Murphy, Hudson Stoeser, Owen Heiss, Steven Fullerton, Hayden Shaffer, Gunner Gehring, Logan Meyer, Leander Austin, Pryce Dyk, DJ Highbear, Mathew Rounds, and Lucas Stoltenburg. "With the size and caliber of our program right now, the ability to wrestle with state qualifiers and placers every day in practice provides such a competitive

advantage," said Paul Turman, advanced "We group coach. have competed regionally and nationally all vear long and I firmly I believe that our kids will be comfortable wrestling at this level come Saturday."

The wrestling club has consistently taken approximately 50 wrestlers to the state tournament during the past nine

years and constantly returns with a large number of state finalists. This past year, of the 63 state qualifiers a total of 38 placed at the state tournament, with 13 advancing to the state finals and 7 individual champions. Shawn Lewis, head high school wrestling coach, commented that "There is a reason why we can come off of a back-to-back performance as state champions and finish 2^{nd} at the state high school tournament. As coaches we are inheriting technically sound young wrestlers and thus they are able to be competitive the very first year on varsity. Our youth program is the reason why our last four 106 lbers have placed in the top four in their first year of varsity experience."

Wrestling begins on Saturday morning at 8:00 for the younger wrestlers, and then the older kids wrestle starting at 2:00. Those placing at the tournament will compete on Sunday in the placing round. Individual place winners for all six age divisions include:
