## Youth Wrestlers Place 38 at State AAU Tournament

During their Region tournament on March 15<sup>th</sup>, the Governor Youth program qualified 62 wrestlers wrestlers for the State AAU Wrestling Tournament which was this past Saturday and Sunday in Rapid City. This high number of qualifiers helped propel the program to an outstanding performance during the two day event with 38 wrestlers advancing into the placing round on Sunday. Hosted by the South Dakota Wrestling Coaches Association, the event included more than 1300 wrestlers representing wrestling clubs from throughout the state.

After competition concluded on Saturday, a total of 15 Pierre wrestlers had advanced into the championship matches for their respective weight classes. These 15 wrestlers and the remaining 23 club members (excluding Cadets who finished their division on Saturday) then competed in the placing rounds held on Sunday to finally award the top eight place winners in each weight class.

Governor wrestlers found themselves in a great position to finish the season on a high note with 11 of the 15 finishing as state champions for the program. These included Ethan Martinmaas, Elijah Boutchee, Gabe Turman, Maguire Raske, Lincoln Turman, William Turman, LeAnder Austin, Austin Senger, Aric Williams, Lucas Stoltenburg, and Levi Stoltenburg. Finishing second at the tournament were Noah Williams, Brady Getz, Garrett Leesman, and Michael Lusk.

Of the fifteen finalists competing in the championship rounds, only three (Boutchee, Austin, and Aric Williams) had not seen action on the main stage in previous

state AAU tournaments. Gabe Turman won his second straight state title. and Martinmaas, Raske, Lincoln Turman, Austin Senger, and Levi Stoltenburg added a second title to their list of accomplishments. William Turman earned his third state title advancing his fifth after to state championship match. Lucas Stoltenburg had made the finals on two previous attempts but fell short each time. Brady Getz advanced into his third state finals match, and Noah Williams earned his third trip after winning two back-to-back title two years ago. Lusk lost a close finals match which served as his sixth straight finals appearance, and Leesman lost 2-0 after winning his second state title two years ago.

Trevor Wiebe, president of the Governor Youth Wrestling program, noted "We certainly are doing something right with our program as we continue to be one of the most competitive programs in the state. To provide a comparison of the success of our program, the next highest

number of state qualifiers came from Watertown which advanced 39 wrestlers to the tournament, just one more than we had place at the tournament."

Also placing at the were Andrew event Snyder, Blake Judson, Will Van Camp, Jace Bench-Bresher, Gage Gehring, Skyler Leesman (third), Hudson Stoeser. Broch Zeeb, Xoe Murphy, Cadin Buchholz (fourth), Rylan Shrake, Jayden Wiebe, Matthew King, Jack Van Camp (fifth), Steven Fullerton, DJ High Bear

(sixth), Owen Heiss, Gunnar Gehring, Pryce Dyk (seventh), Noah Horsley, Gavin Stotts, and Hayden Shaffer (eighth). From this list, nine have advanced to the state finals at previous tournaments (Judson, Will and Jack Van Camp, Bench-Bresher, Gunner and Gage Gehring, Dyk, Shrake, and Stotts)

"While we would love to see every one of our kids have a chance at state championship, we emphasize how important it just to survive the first day of competition and make it into the placing round, said Paul Turman, advanced group coach. "At our last practice I reminded them that Austin Senger had placed third at the state AAU tournament just last year, and he still found himself in state finals for the Governor program as an 8<sup>th</sup> grader. Kids that get this experience learn the valuable lesson about what it takes to help a high school team score crucial team points once they hit the varsity lineup."

While the folkstyle wrestling season
